While California Community College (CCC) system fees are much lower than tuition at state universities and colleges, the total cost of attending a CCC — which includes books, housing, transportation, and food — is much higher than most people realize. Because many students don't calculate the "real" cost of attending a CCC, they do not take advantage of the grants and loans available to help them pay for their college education. For many students getting financial aid would allow them to work less, study more, and complete a degree, certificate, or transfer.
