What behaviors does a responsible person demonstrate?

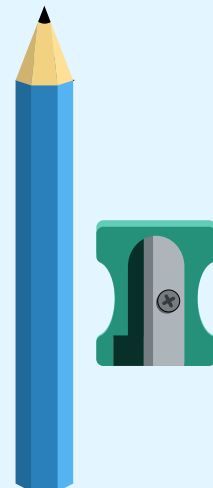
HONEST
